

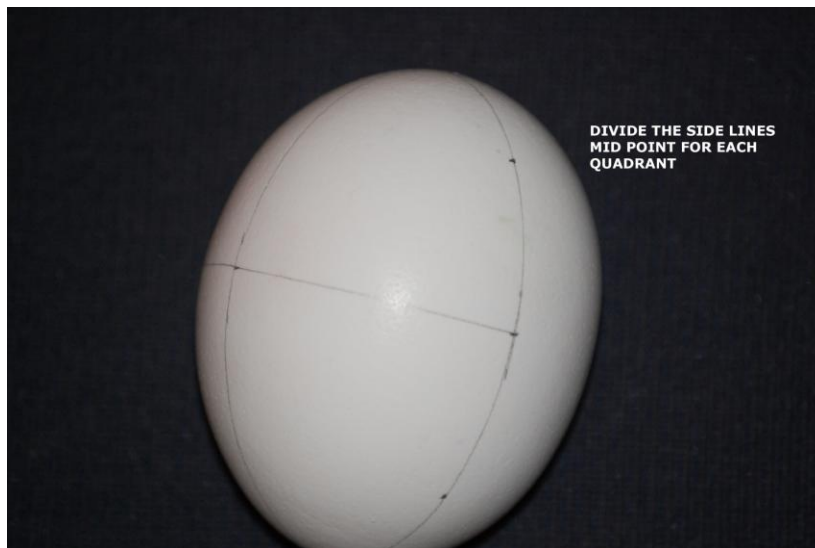
MEASURING OUT A DOUBLE-STAR MOTIF

A START BY DIVIDING THE EGG INTO FOUR QUADRANTS



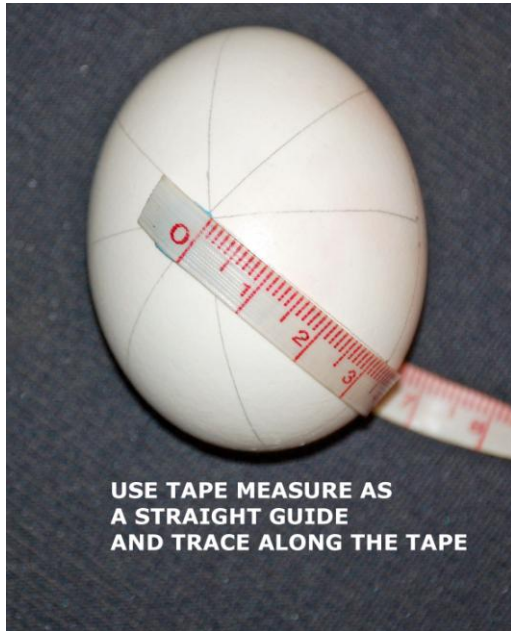
USE A RUBBER BAND TO TRACE ALONG THE MARKED POINTS ON THE EGG

B USING A TAPE MEASURE, DIVIDE THE SIDE LINES IN HALF FOR EACH QUADRANT

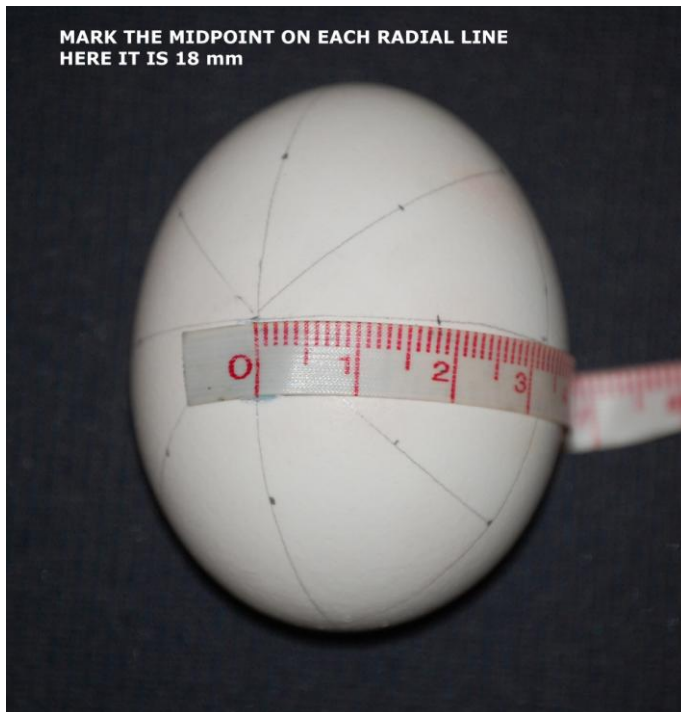


MINE MEASURED 2 cm

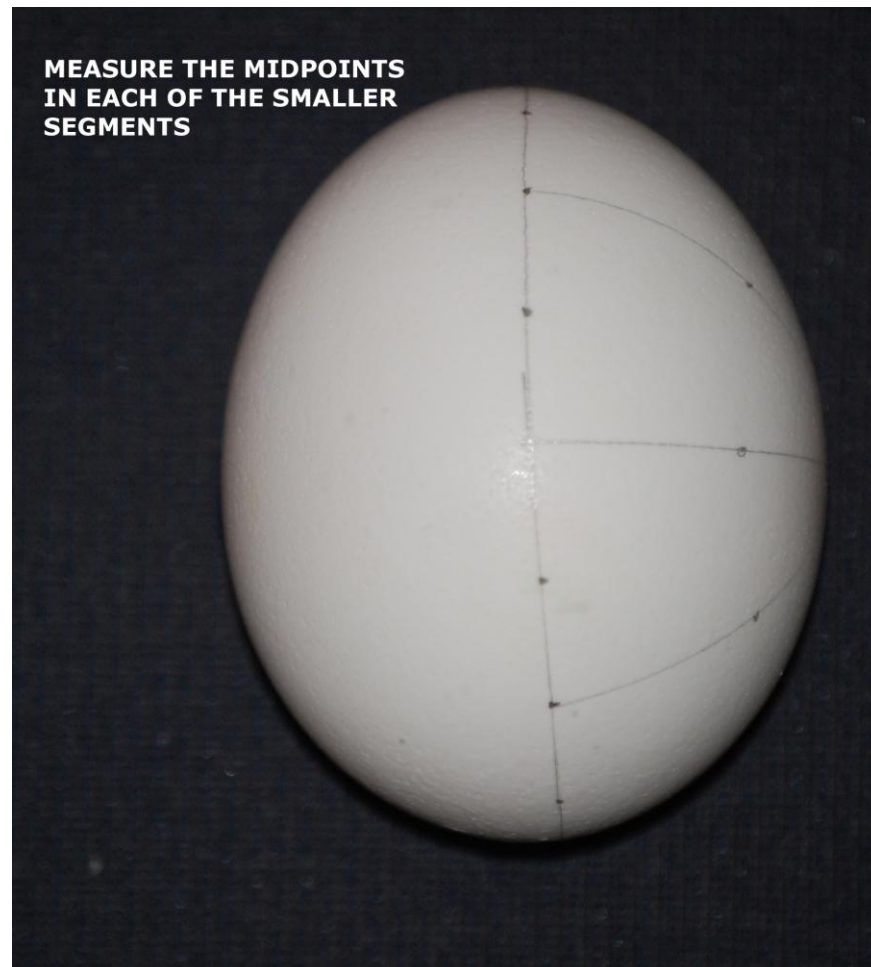
C DRAW THE DIAGONAL LINES FROM THE CENTER OUT TO THE EDGE



D MEASURE HALF OF THE RADIAL LINES AND MARK THE HALF POINT WITH A DOT



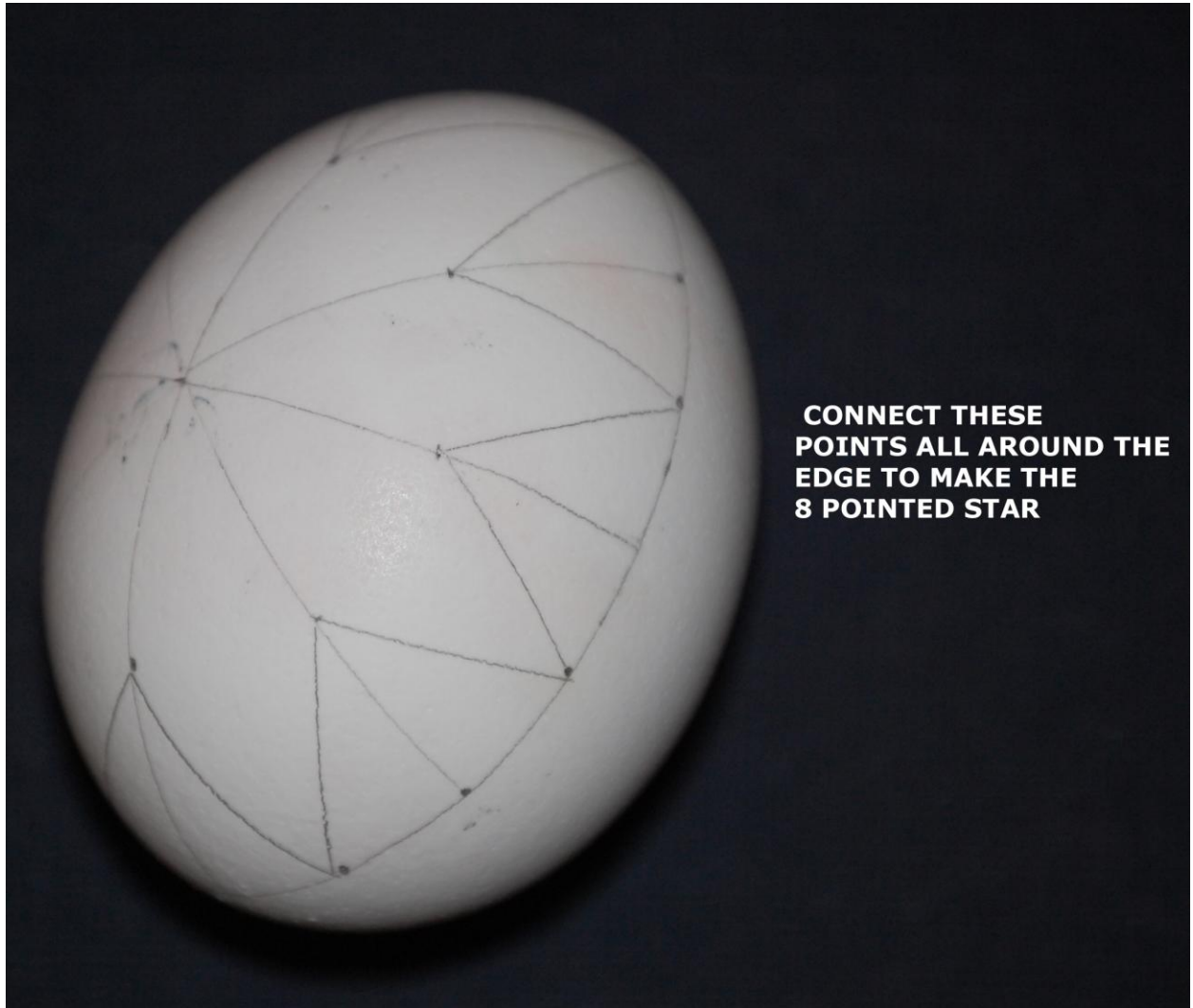
E BEGINNING TO MAKE THE POINTS OF THE STAR



MY HALFWAY POINT MEASURED 1 cm

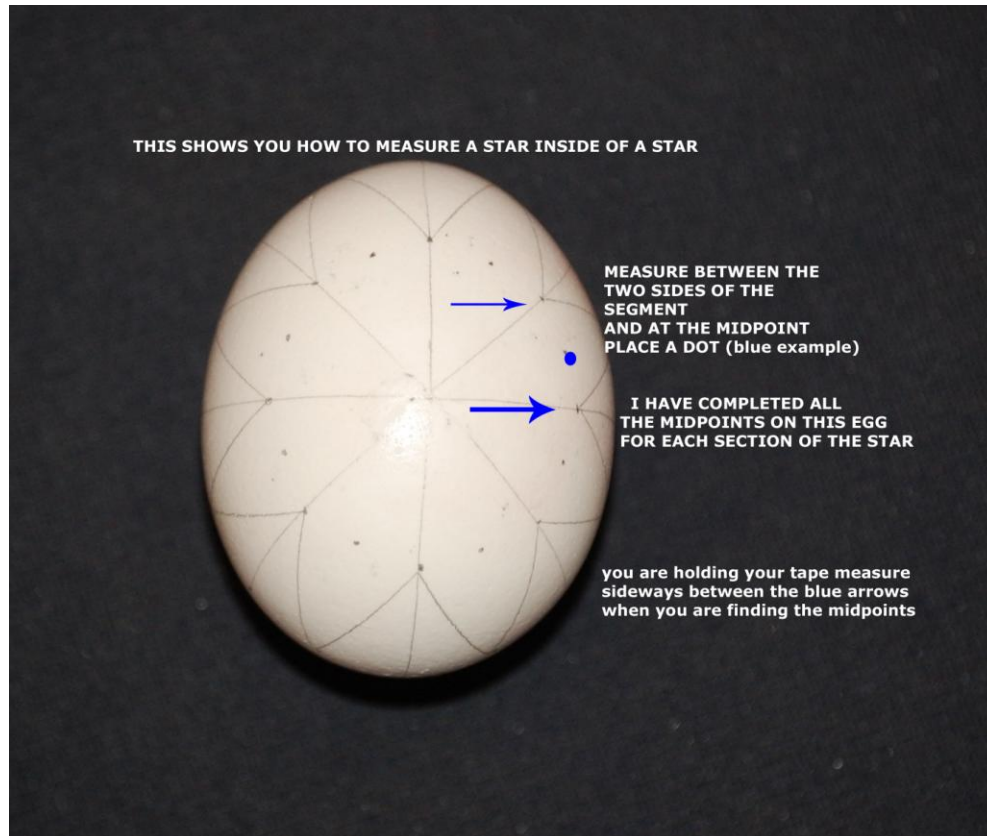
CAN YOU SEE THE THREE POINTS OF THE STAR? NEXT YOU WILL CONNECT THE POINTS

F YOU CAN SEE THE STAR EMERGE IN THIS PHOTO



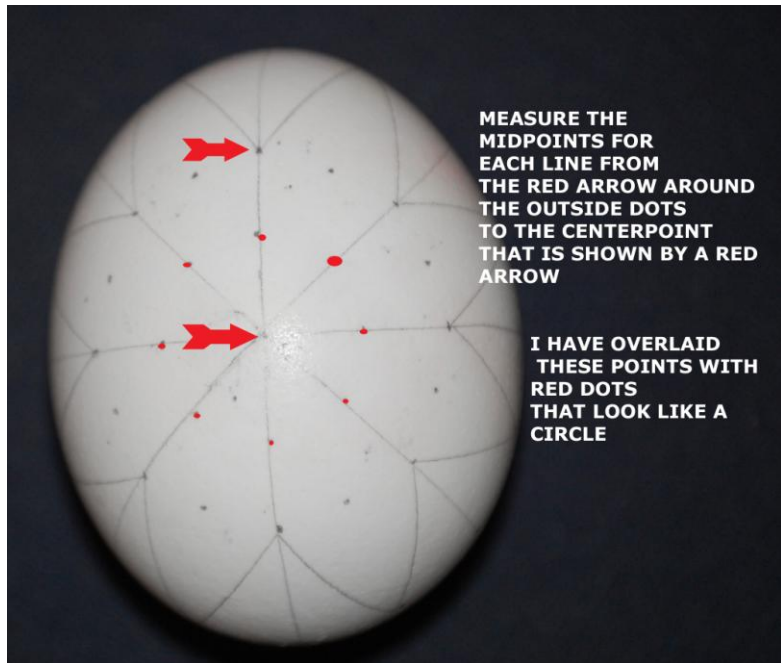
**CONNECT THESE

G HERE IS HOW TO MEASURE OUT A SECOND STAR INSIDE OF THE FIRST STAR

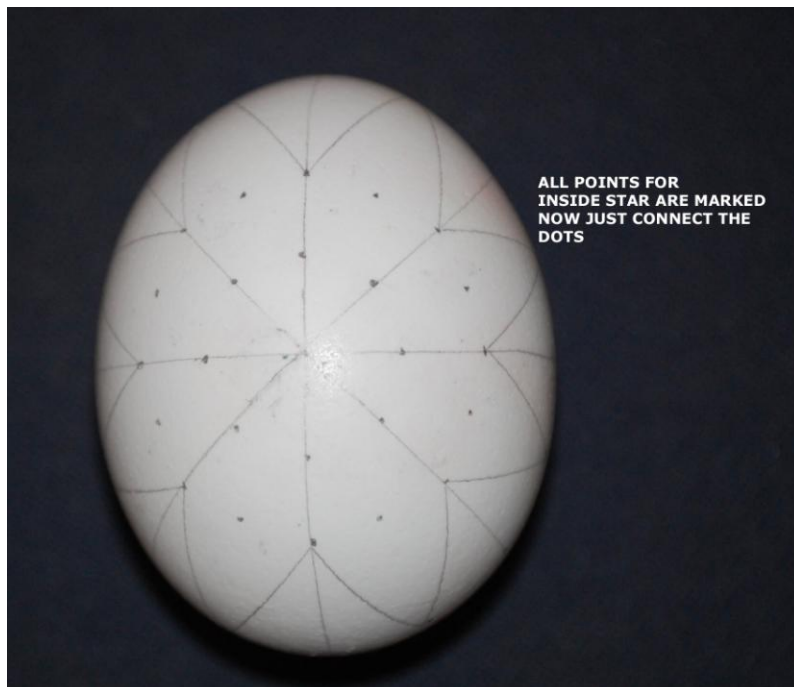


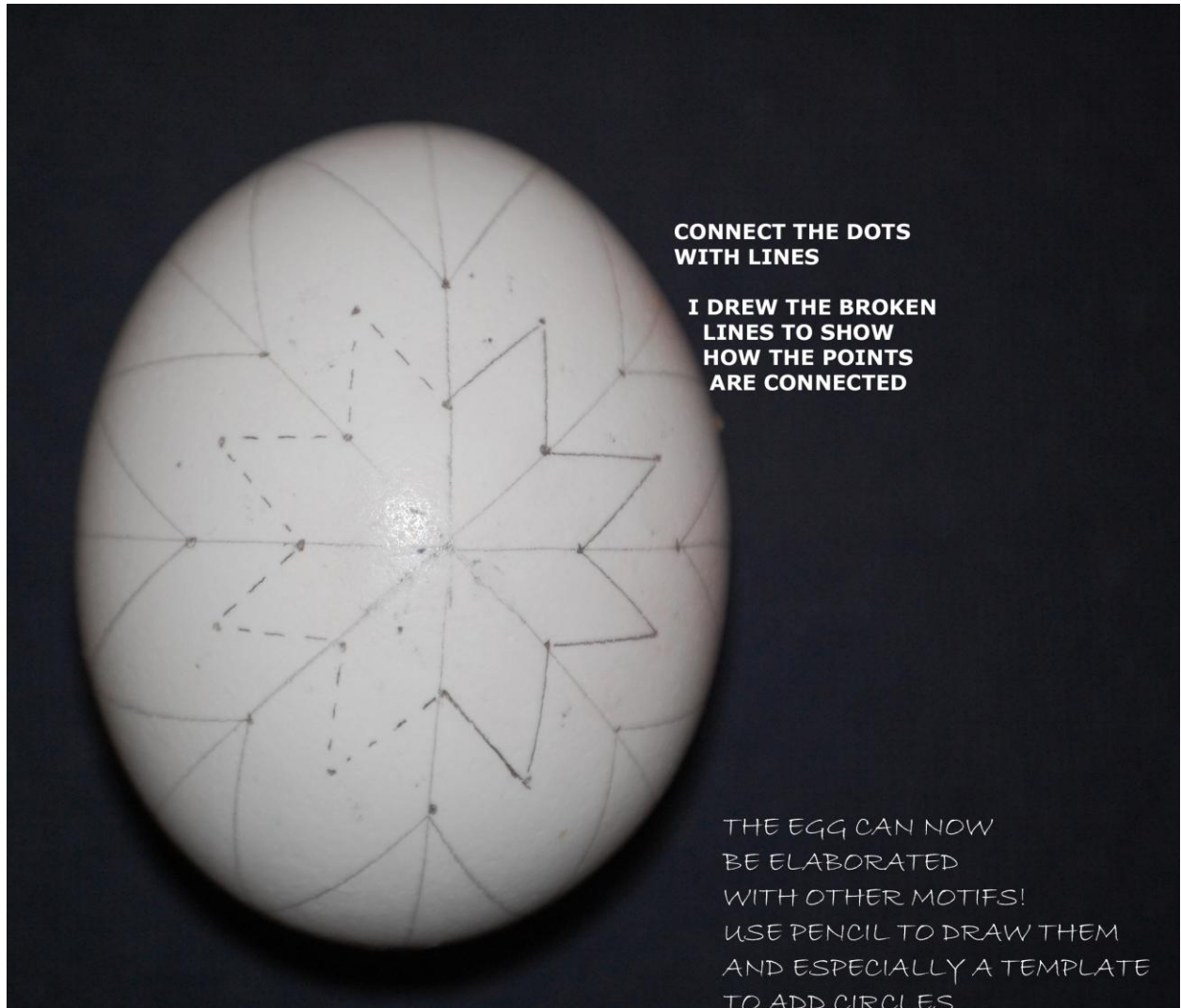
I MEASURED OUT 6mm as the halfway point
